ESSENTIAL CAREGIVER VISIT CHECKLIST

All Essential Caregivers must schedule their visits before coming to the building. Please check-in at the front desk when you arrive.

Only those who are designated as Essential Caregivers by the resident(s) they are coming to visit will be allowed in the building.

All visitors of Ebenezer communities will be screened for symptoms and COVID-19 risk using our Wellness Screening Tools which includes a temperature check at each visit.

Please sanitize hands upon entering the building.

Essential Caregivers must wear a visitor's badge with the name and apartment/room number of the residents they are visiting.

Personal Protective Equipment

Essential Caregivers must supply their own masks and face shields. We may have extra on hand, but we cannot guarantee PPE will be available. If we do supply a face shield, please return it so it can be sanitized.



Building Access

After checking in, proceed directly to the apartment of the resident you are visiting.

Please maintain appropriate social distance while traversing the common areas.

While in the building, the EC may only visit their resident's apartment and not have other residents come into the apartment during the visit.

Stay in the resident's apartment/room. You may go to the laundry room or garbage room if needed. You must wear a mask and a face shield while traveling to these areas.

Taking resident out of the building

The EC is only allowed to take residents out of the building for medical appointments. Any resident who leaves the building for any other reason than a medical appointment may be asked to quarantine within their apartment for 14 days.

COVID-19 Symptoms

Essential Caregivers must inform us if they develop a fever or symptoms consistent with COVID-19 within 14 days of a visit to the resident.

If the resident develops symptoms or tests positive, we will inform the Essential Caregiver. You cannot visit when a resident is positive for COVID-19 or symptomatic, unless the visit is for compassionate care. If an outbreak occurs in the community this exception to the visiting restrictions may be suspended.
